A context-free grammar is a notation for describing languages It is more powerful than finite automata or RE's, but still cannot define all possible languages Useful for nested structures, eg, parentheses in programming languages

the grammar Specifically a context free grammar (CFG) is defined by a set of productions in which the left hand side of the production is a single nonterminal which may be replaced by the right hand side anywhere where the left hand side occurs, regardless of the context in which the left hand side symbol occurs Hence "context free"

Context-Free Grammars

A context-free grammar (CFG) consists of a set of productions that you use to replace a variable by a string of variables and terminals The language of a grammar is the set of strings it generates A language is context-free if there is a CFG for it Goddard 6a: 20

Context-Free Grammars (CFG)

Definition of Context-Free Grammar A CFG (or just a grammar) G is a tuple $G = (V, T, P, S)$ where 1 V is the (finite) set of variables (or nonterminals or syntactic categories) Each variable represents a language, ie, a set of strings 2 T is a finite set of terminals, ie, the symbols that form the strings of the language being defined 3
